

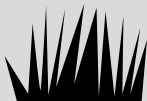
CUCKOOING

Know the signs



Gardens are overgrown



Curtains and blinds are closed during the day



Damage to doors or windows



Children that have no clear connection to the resident



Locks on internal doors



Piles of takeaway boxes or containers
