Travelling to the University

We recommend that you use public transport to travel to the University as there is very little parking available on campus. A taxi from Leeds Station to the School of Law will take approximately 15 minutes and cost about £5. Alternatively the number 56 bus runs from Albion Street via Woodhouse Lane (A660) and stops on Moorland Road. These run every 10 minutes.

If you are driving to this event we advise that you use one of the main city centre car parks, most of which are only a short walk from our campus. We also recommend that you allow additional time to find a parking space, as traffic can get congested in the city centre.

Below are details of some city centre car parks:

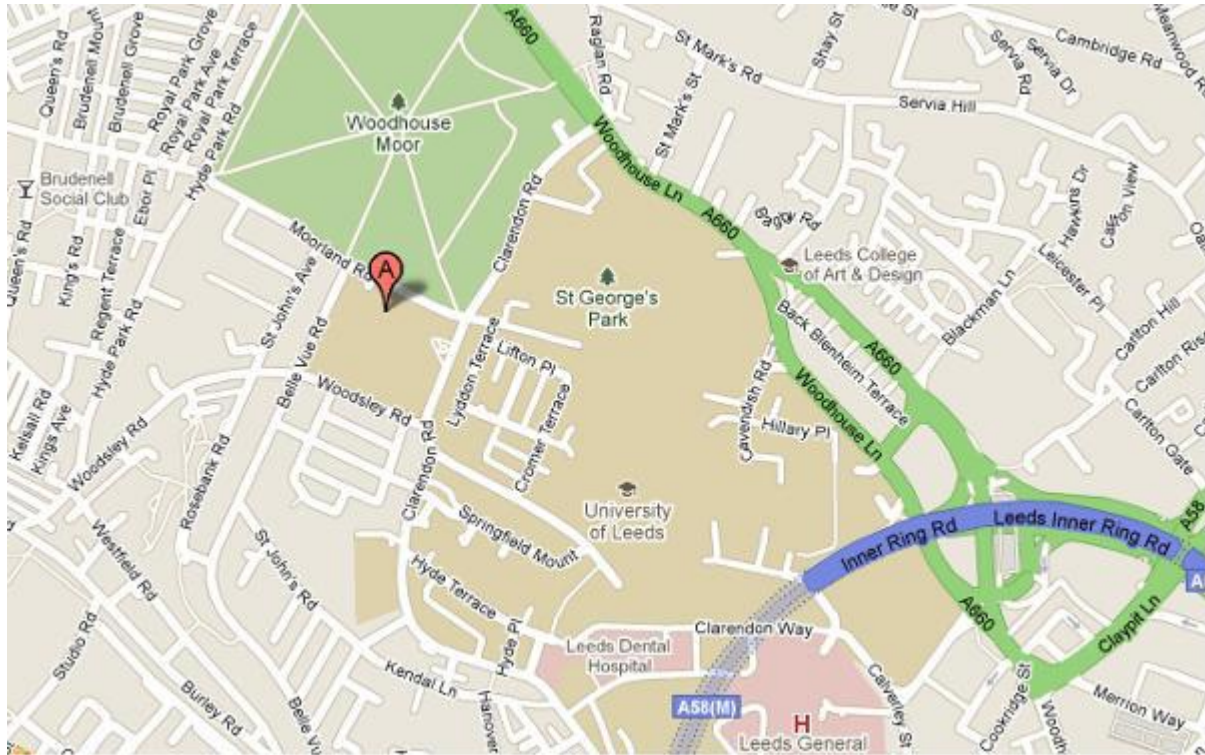
- Woodhouse Lane Multi-Storey (LS1 3HQ, 0.1 miles from campus)
- Merrion Centre (LS2 8PD, 0.5 miles from campus)
- St John's Centre (NCP) (LS2 8LQ, 0.7 miles from campus)
- The Light (LS1 8TL, 0.7 miles from campus)
