Call for Papers

The School of Law of the University of Leeds is pleased to announce its annual one-day PGR Conference. The theme of this year's Conference will be "the role of the law in an ever-changing society: national and international challenges in the 2020s".

The Conference will be held at the School of Law of the University of Leeds on the 1st of May 2020. It will provide a great opportunity for Postgraduate Researchers (PGRs) in Law and Criminology to present their work and receive valuable feedback and to develop their scholarship in a constructive and collaborative environment for PGRs. PGRs at any stage in their research studies are encouraged to participate.

We welcome submissions within the following three Conference streams on a number of topics, including but not limited to:

- Business Law: Commercial law; corporate law; intellectual property law; tax law; technology and business law; competition law; insolvency law; international trade law; private international law; contract law and European Union law.
- Criminal Justice Studies: Policing; penology; security; technology; cybercrime; counter-terrorism; criminology; evidence; youth crime and justice; criminal justice policy; criminal justice processes; criminal justice agencies; international and comparative criminology and historic criminology.
- Law and Social Justice: Human rights; public international law; healthcare law; disability law; law and inequality; legal education; labour law; law, gender and sexuality; social and legal theory; and activism.

Abstract submission, bursaries and deadline

Abstracts should specify the Conference stream they relate to. They should not exceed 300 words and must be submitted to **lawpgrconf@leeds.ac.uk** by **Friday**, **the 28th of February 2020 at noon**. Successful applicants will be notified by the 20th of March 2020.

The Conference is completely free of charge. Refreshments and lunch will be provided. A number of bursaries of £300 each are available to help towards the cost of travel and accommodation for external PGRs who present at the Conference. If you wish to apply for a bursary then you must state this on your submission, attach a copy of your CV and specify under which Conference stream you are applying to present.
