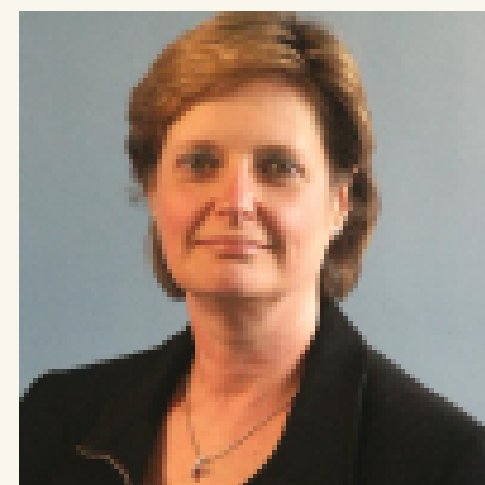
ETHICS AND EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH: CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS
